

Position & Objectives:

Diesel Mechanic – This is a full-time position, which performs scheduled preventative maintenance and necessary repairs to trucks (light and heavy), utility vans, and other heavy equipment as specified in manufacturer designed procedures or accepted industry practices. They will also be responsible to disassemble and overhaul motors, transmissions, clutches, rear ends, electrical systems, and all other assemblies.

Responsibilities and goals included but not limited to:**ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Perform quality repairs and maintenance on all Heavy Truck and Diesel Engines as specified in manufacturer designed procedures or accepted industry practices.
- Accurately complete all paperwork including repair information on work orders, information for state and emission inspections, etc.
- Dedication and adherence to all company and industry safety standards
- Diagnose failures of vehicles and disassemble repair and reassemble parts as necessary
- Perform preventative maintenance on vehicles, annual inspections
- Answer road calls
- Maintain vehicle records as required
- Maintain and repair heavy equipment
- Maintain records such as daily check list (pre-trip inspection)
- Regular, reliable, predictable attendance

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED

- High School Diploma or GED equivalent
- Valid Driver's License; CDL preferred
- 2 years experience as a class A and/or B mechanic

- 2 years experience working with heavy equipment in similar environment.
- Must be knowledgeable of OSHA regulations
- Must be able to pass a drug screen and criminal background check
- Must be willing to work varying shifts, and weekends.
- Ability to work efficiently with a high degree of independence
- Position also requires a number of physical movements including lifting, pinching, bending, reaching, climbing, and manipulating and handling objects.
- Aptitude to effectively present information and respond to questions from managers, drivers/operators.
- Proficient in Microsoft applications, email, internet operations and all basic computer functions.
- Capability to learn corporate software.
- Ability to define problems, collect data, establish facts and draw valid conclusions.
